*Servers provide food and beverage service to the customers of O'Malley's on the Green in a prompt and courteous manner. This position may serve in three areas - snack shop, banquets, and restaurant. All three areas are tipped positions. ***English fluency is essential for success!*

Snack shop is quick service - hotdogs, hamburgers, snacks - which requires restocking often. Opening and closing duties, general cleaning. Sells beverages on the golf course from the beverage cart with international drivers license.

Restaurants - Take customer orders, deliver meals and drinks, input orders using electronic system, and clean up after customers. In addition, help maintain order and abide by all state and local liquor laws.

Banquets - Setup rooms and buffets for service to large groups, bus tables, and clean up rooms upon event completion

BENEFITS:

While working for Anchorage Golf Course/O'Malley's on the Green, you will be surrounded by the surreal Alaskan scenery with a spectacular view of North America's tallest peak, Denali! If you enjoy wildlife, then prepare yourself for daily encounters with the mighty moose and the possibility of seeing eagles, black bears, and foxes. Pay is to be determined based on Alaskan law, as of 2025 it is \$13 per hour, plus gratuities. This is a tipped position, you will make tips in addition to your hourly wage. Every day you will have the opportunity to interact and practice your English skills with fellow employees and customers.

We will pick up our students from the airport (ANC is the international airport in Anchorage), show them the facility, and take them to their housing. We would prefer students to arrive between 8AM and 8PM, any day of the week. We will show them where shopping is, take them to the Social Security office (either on day of arrival or the following day), give rides to the bank to set up an account and assist them as needed, and show them the golf course/introduce them to our department heads. We will give them time to get to/take them to the grocery store and provide them with bicycles.

Make your appointment with the Social Security office before arrival. They are usually booked out a few weeks and you will need one in order to set up direct deposit for your paycheck.

We will also provide email and cell phone information of each department head to the students to confirm arrival information/pickup well in advance.
