Housekeepers are responsible for cleaning rooms and common areas, vacuuming, changing linens and towels, making beds, cleaning bathrooms, and doing laundry (washing, drying, folding). This position can be physically demanding and you may be required to use chemical cleaning products. Your employer may ask you to perform other duties related to your job type.
