Food Prep/Cook Assistant employees are required to perform various food and beverage related tasks including:

- Cooking or preparing food items according to procedures or recipes.
- Placing food items on serving plates or dishes along with required condiments and utensils to present to customers.
- Preparing items quickly and accurately ensuring no waste and in accordance with production and portion requirements and quality standards while maintaining a safe, sanitary work environment.
- Maintaining and cleaning all Food Service areas according to all county, state, and federal health codes and sanitation procedures including preparation tables, equipment, floors, supply areas, refrigerators, and coolers.
- Washing all dirty dishes and equipment.
- Ensuring that cooking grease is rotated properly.
- Maintaining all necessary food reporting and labeling to ensure product quality.
- At the beginning of the day, responsible for getting food preparation areas stocked and set-up.
- At the end of the day, responsible for cleaning up food preparation areas and properly storing unused food items.

- Keeping supervisor/manager informed of all supply, food, and product inventory when necessary.
- Keeping supervisor/manager informed of situations relating to facility operation, patron complaints or concerns, accidents, emergency situations, damages, and potential safety hazards.
- Attend departmental and team meetings as well as participate in all additional training courses.
- Perform all duties in a safe manner.

Must be able to work individually or on a team and at a quick pace. Must have the ability to read, write, and understand instructions given in the English language. Workers serve as a representative of our company and must display courtesy, respect, tact, and discretion in all interactions with other employees, management, owners, guests, and members of the local community. Employees will be required to use mechanical kitchen equipment and sharp cutting tools and knives. Employees will be exposed to high temperature ovens and fryers. Proper protective gloves will be provided. All workers will perform physical activities that require moving one's whole body, such as lifting, balancing, climbing, and stooping or bending. These activities often also require considerable use of the arms and legs. Employees must be able to work continuously in an indoor, humid or hot environment without air-conditioning. Employees may be moved to different work areas as needed.

Participants can stay at Smoky Mountain Student Lodge, a dormitory-style student housing located in downtown Gatlinburg, just a short walk from Bubba Gump Shrimp Co. Rooms include shared kitchens, laundry facilities, and WiFi. Typical costs are around \$100 per week. Students are responsible for securing and paying for housing. Airbnb is a recommendation! Please rent a house together and split the cost. How to Find Housing: Visit www.airbnb.com or www.vrbo.com Search for rentals near where Bubba Gump is located. Set filters for entire home/apartment, stay length (May-August), and your group size. Choose homes with WiFi, kitchen, laundry, and parking for convenience. Message hosts before booking to confirm monthly rates, total costs, and that multiple tenants are allowed. Once approved, split the rental cost evenly among roommates using Airbnb's group payment option or direct payment arrangements.

Transportation for Community Housing Description:

Walking & Biking

- Many housing locations and the downtown worksite are within walking distance; if you're housed nearby the Parkway area, walking is quite viable.
- For biking, there are trail options like the Gatlinburg Trail (approx. 2 miles one way) that provides a scenic, mostly flat route.

Local Public Transit (Trolley System)

- The Gatlinburg Trolley System operates daily on multiple color-coded routes, with stops throughout Gatlinburg (100+ stops) and a major hub at the Mass Transit Center.
- Service hours vary seasonally: ex.; May-Oct ~8:30a.m.-12a.m
- The trolley is **free** for passengers in Gatlinburg.
- From housing to worksite: typically a short walk from a trolley stop to your housing and to the restaurant downtown.

Other Options

- Rideshare services (Uber/Lyft) and taxis are available but during peak tourist times wait times may be longer and fares higher.

Participants should plan to arrive in Gatlinburg **a few days before their start date** to allow time for housing check-in and local orientation. There is **no employer-provided transportation**, so please arrange your own travel to Gatlinburg.

Getting Here

- The nearest major airport is **McGhee Tyson Airport (TYS)** in Knoxville, Tennessee — about 45 miles (1.5 hours) from Gatlinburg.
- From the airport, you can use regional shuttle services (such as **Rocky Top Tours**, www.rockytoptours.com) or rideshare options (Uber, Lyft, or taxi). Prices typically range from **\$50-\$100** one way.

- Bus service is limited; however, **Greyhound** runs to Knoxville, and local transit (Sevier County Transit) connects to Gatlinburg.

Once in town, **Gatlinburg Trolley** offers affordable local transportation (fares \$0.50-\$2.00 per ride). Most housing and the restaurant are walkable from downtown Gatlinburg.

Details about how to apply for Social Security Number:

1. Ensure your work authorization is active and wait at least 7-10 business days after arrival so your status is visible in SSA's system. 2. Gather the required documents: your passport with J-1 visa, your I-94 arrival/departure record, your DS-2019, and your employer's letter verifying you have job offer and work authorization. 3. Make an appointment online for the local Social Security Administration (SSA) Field Office in person, complete Form SS-5 (Application for Social Security Card) and submit your documents. 4. After submission, your SSN card is mailed to your U.S. address (typically in 2-4 weeks). Once received, share the SSN with your employer for payroll reporting.

Grooming Requirements - Landry's: Uniform must be clean and neat. Hair should be tidy and natural-colored; long hair tied back for food handling. Facial hair must be well-groomed; tattoos should be professional and non-offensive. Minimal jewelry; facial piercings limited to small studs. Maintain excellent personal hygiene and clean, short nails.

Maintain professionalism at all times. Personal cell phones allowed only during breaks. Smoking is prohibited on worksites and in company housing. Work schedules may vary; punctuality and reliability are required. Follow all safety and food-handling procedures.

All Landry's employees get 50% discount at Landry's restaurants for them and up to 4 people. Some of our fine dining restaurants only offer a 25% discount for employees and up to 3 people. This is outlined in our handbook.

Participants MUST show proof of having applied for Social Security within 30 days of arrival. In addition, participants MUST report their social security number to their employer once they receive it. If you do not report your SSN to your employer you may be given limited hours.
