The house at 231 Daniel Webster Hwy is located directly behind Hart's restaurant, a quick walk across the parking lot to the entrance. The other 2 are located in the same nice quiet neighborhood, across the street from Hart's, a 3 minute walk away. All are full of charm and character and offer an easy walk to downtown Meredith. All offer the basic amenities of a home. We offer shared bedrooms (not coed unless specifically arranged prior to arrival based on availability). We have non-coed bathrooms as well. Each home offers a large open eat in kitchen, with common living areas attached. They all have bright, sunny porches or decks and have decent outdoor yard space. The houses are fully furnished and are supplied with basic kitchen cookware and utensils. There is a television and a full kitchen and microwave. Each home has on-site laundry. Bed linens are not provided. You may bring your own, or arrange for us to have some provided for a fee. There is also Wi-Fi provided in all houses.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Arrival Instructions:

We suggest that you fly into Boston Logan International Airport (BOS) - <http://www.massport.com/logan-airport/> - and take the bus through Concord Coach Lines - <https://concordcoachlines.com/> - that leaves right from the airport and brings you directly to Meredith, NH. The cost of the bus ticket is around \$30 and travel time by bus from Boston to Meredith is about 2.5-3 hours. We will pick the students up at the Meredith bus stop between the hours of 9am-9pm. We will not pick up from the airport in Boston. The bus generally leaves BOS at 3:40pm and arrives in Meredith around 6:35pm. Try to keep this in mind when scheduling flights into Boston.

You MUST be in contact and email flight itineraries to Andrea Weeks at andrea@hartsturkeyfarm.com at least 2 weeks before your departure so we can plan for your arrival. Details about a scheduled pickup will be communicated to the student prior to their departure.

Upon arrival, students will be shown the work site, housing, and we will arrange a first trip to the grocery store (students are responsible after this trip). We will also arrange transportation to the Social Security office as well.

You are representing our business, we need you to look professional. Students must be neatly groomed, clean, and professional in appearance. Must practice good overall hygiene, bathing regularly and wearing deodorant. Hair must be natural in color (no pink, blue, green, etc) and no visibly offensive tattoos or facial piercings. No overbearing perfumes or colognes are to be used.

Applicable Company Policies:

This is hard work and you will need to be physically fit and ready to work hard. You will need to be able to lift/pull/carry up to 40lbs and push up to 100lbs. You need to be able to bend and lift up to 40lbs (trays). You need to be able to continually move at a fast pace and you will be required to handle objects and reach outward and above shoulder level. You need to be able to stand for your entire shift. You need to be able to go up and down stairs. It will get HOT in the kitchen!

Use of cell phones for personal use during work hours are restricted. Hart's is a non-smoking establishment for employees across the property. Smoking at employee housing is only permitted outside.

We are open 7 days a week, year round. Must have a flexible availability and be able to work nights, weekends, and holidays.

Days off with friends and traveling companions are not guaranteed - requests filled when able.

Scheduling may change weekly and you must be prepared to work accordingly.

You are expected to show up for work on time and not miss shifts. If you are going to be late or absent, you need to speak directly with your department supervisor. Failure to do so will result in a warning.
