Artists will take a bus or taxi from the bus station or the airport to the Broadway at the Beach which is the job location, or wherever they are staying.*

If you arrive during the day, between 10am - 5pm, you should take a taxi or bus to Broadway at Beach and meet Jasmine Kaniuk there, and she will bring you to your housing.

If you arrive outside of business hours (5pm - 10am), then you should take a taxi straight to your housing location.

Housing is right across from where you are working.

You need to be in touch with Jasmine at myrtlebeachartists@gmail.com before you arrive to ensure she will be able to bring you to housing that day. You should not just arrive without being in touch ahead of time.
