Schedules come out every few days as events and times may vary, so students need to be flexible. Event Maintenance schedule tends to be Mondays-Fridays 8am-4pm and Sundays 8am-2pm. Tent Crew schedule is similar, but may be more of a variation of dates and times based on need. Students generally get Saturdays off, but no guarantee.

Second jobs are a possibility, but those hours will need to be in the evenings. Vermont Tent Company is your primary employer, and second jobs should not impact your schedule or work with us.
